Hi, Talquin Members, I am Kim Gay with Talquin Electric Cooperative. During the last year, we have heard concerns from Members regarding those who were unable to pay their utility bill due to emergency situations. In response to these conversations, we are pleased to launch “TAP”, the Talquin Assistance Program. It is our desire that this program will make a positive difference in our community.

"TAP" is completely **VOLUNTARY**. The intent of this Program is to provide a means for Members to lend a helping hand to their fellow Members who are in need. Members may donate to this program by choosing to have their account(s) rounded up to the nearest dollar on their monthly utility bill. The funds contributed will be used to assist Talquin Members who cannot pay their utility bill due to job loss, illness, or other crisis circumstances. During the onset of this Program all screening will be handled by Capital Area Community Action for Leon, Gadsden, and Liberty Counties and by Salvation Army for Wakulla County.

In order to qualify to receive TAP funds, Members must contact Capital Area Community Action or Salvation Army and apply. The enclosed form will only be used for Members to sign up to **CONTRIBUTE** to TAP.

Members may sign up to **VOLUNTARILY** contribute to “TAP” by completing the form on the back and returning it to any Talquin Area Office. Members may withdraw from the Program at any time by contacting any Area Office.
