Students will be selected as Talquin delegates and will visit the Florida state capital for a two day, all expense paid conference on February 10-11, 2010. While in Tallahassee, students will be introduced to the Cooperative and Florida's legislative process while visiting the state's capital. Students will vote on issues while visiting the House of Representatives' Chambers and attend a mock session in the Supreme Court. During this conference, four students will be chosen to represent Talquin in Washington, D.C. for the National Rural Electric Youth Tour held June 12-17, 2010. The Washington, D.C. trip will include visits to the Lincoln Memorial, Arlington National Cemetery, Mt. Vernon, and many more historic sites with hundreds of other students from around the nation. More highlights include watching the United States Marine Drum and Bugle Corps and the Silent Drill Platoon perform at the Sunset Parade at the Iwo Jima Memorial, and a tour of the Smithsonian Museum and the Holocaust Museum.

In order to qualify:

- Students must currently be enrolled as a junior in a local high school or home school;
- Student's parents or grandparents must be a Talquin Member;
- Students must currently live in Talquin's four county service area (Leon, Gadsden, Wakulla or Liberty County).
