Step I- APPLICATION FOR LINE EXTENSION

1. Engineering Deposit-\$100.00/lot \$500.00Max.
 - Deposit will be applied to your costs
 - Deposit applicable for 12 months
 - Non-refundable if you choose not to move forward with construction

Step III-Field Survey with Engineer

At this time, specific questions can be answered on site by the Engineer. Engineering will explain clearing requirements for which Developer is responsible.

- A. Overhead - 30ft. corridor
 - B. Underground - 20ft. corridor

 2. After meeting the Engineer on site, paperwork will be compiled and a cost summary prepared

Step IV- Requirements prior to construction

Developer completes and signs all paperwork and returns to our office with the necessary fee payments
 Developer must have roadway to grade before any construction begins

All paperwork and fees must be completed before any work is released for construction

Any necessary easements must be obtained(developer may be required to assist in securing needed easements. NOTE: should USFS, State or other permits be required the costs will be absorbed by the developer).
