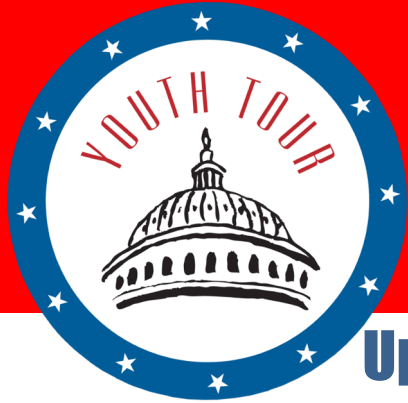


2020 TALQUIN YOUTH TOUR + SCHOLARSHIP Application



Up to \$15,000 in scholarships to be awarded!

Talquin Electric Cooperative is looking for leaders like you to serve as delegates in the 2020 Talquin Youth Tour. Chosen representatives will visit the Florida state capital for a two day overnight conference February 12-13. While in Tallahassee, students will be introduced to the cooperative business model and Florida's legislative process while visiting the state's capitol. Students vote on issues while visiting the House of Representatives' Chambers and attend a session in the Supreme Court. During this conference, four students will be chosen to represent Talquin in Washington, D.C. for the National Rural Electric Youth Tour held June 20-25, 2020. Students will fly to Washington, D.C. and the trip includes visits to the Lincoln Memorial, Arlington National Cemetery, Mt. Vernon, and many more historic sites with hundreds of other students from around the nation. More highlights include watching the Marine Drum and Bugle Corps and the Silent Drill Platoon perform in the Sunset Parade at the Iwo Jima Memorial, and visits to the Smithsonian Museum and the Holocaust Museum. The trip is paid for by Talquin Electric Cooperative.

Qualifications

- Students must currently be enrolled as a junior in a local high school or home school;
- Students must have a close relative/guardian who is currently a Talquin Member;
- Students must currently live in Gadsden, Leon, Liberty, or Wakulla Counties.
- 250-500 word essay titled, "Why I want to be a Talquin Electric Cooperative Youth Tour Representative."
- A letter of recommendation from a school counselor, teacher, pastor, community leader or administrator is also required.
